Now, Capital Aviation no longer has to do business with companies that specialize in the removal of toxic hazardous waste, such as "Clean Harbors" from Plaquemine, Louisiana or "Disposal Systems Inc." from Deer Park, Texas since Capital Aviation no longer generates any toxic hazardous material/s that require disposal. Capital Aviation was generating over 3500 gallons per month of hazardous waste before switching to WEBBERTEK's paint stripper. Now the quantity of toxic hazardous waste generated is zero (0).
